

OKLAHOMA VA HOSPITALS & VA CENTER INFORMATION

This program package includes information on our VA Hospitals and State VA Centers located throughout Oklahoma. Each of these facilities assists our veterans with their physical and mental needs. Some are assisted living facilities, others are hospitals. Their addresses and phone numbers are listed on the back of this report.

The American Legion Auxiliary appoints a Veterans Representative to each facility. These members work tirelessly with the hospitals and centers assisting the veterans. They hold bingo games, ice cream socials, tea parties for female veterans, fishing tournaments and much, much more.

The Department of Oklahoma sends \$80.00 each month to both hospitals and all 7 VA centers with the exception of Christmas when we send \$100.00 to all. We have some units who donate funds to specific centers on a regular basis. Others provide needed items for the veterans.

A "Wish List" of items is attached for each VA Hospital and VA Center. Anything that your unit, or community, can provide will be very much appreciated.
